

Rules and Regulations during Aquatic Reservations

Additional Terms and Conditions Specific to all Aquatic Contracts

USE OF PREMISES

1. The Reservation holder shall comply at all times with the facility-specific rules posted at the Premises and all directions or instructions provided by the staff at the Premises in respect of the particular conditions, requirements or safety considerations during the reservation time. The City may amend the facility-specific rules and requirements from time to time, and the facility staff may amend the rules and regulations from time to time. In the event that the facility specific requirements and rules are found to be inconsistent, contrary to, or in conflict with the wording in these Terms and Conditions, the facility specific requirements shall apply to the extent of any inconsistency.
2. Reservation holder agrees and acknowledges that all persons under the influence of intoxicants will not be permitted to use or access the facility. Reservation holder will ensure that none of their users are under the influence of intoxicants, and acknowledges that the consumption of alcohol and/or drugs on the Premises is not permitted. Reservation holder will cooperate with facility staff to ensure the removal of any user who violates this rule.
3. The Reservation holder agrees and acknowledges that in the event that its users are not complying with these Terms and Conditions, and/or the facility specific requirements, the facility staff may remove any or all users from the particular reservation, and/or may revoke all future reservation privileges to the Reservation holder.
4. Reservation holder agrees and acknowledges that there may be circumstances beyond the City's control which result in an unanticipated pool closure, which affects the Reservation holder's designated time on short notice (ie: emergency situation, mechanical failure etc.). In those circumstances, the City and Reservation holder will work together to reschedule the reservation at a mutually agreeable time.

POOL SAFETY RULES SPECIFIC TO ALL RESERVATION GROUPS

5. Reservation holder agrees and acknowledges that at all times, all users within the Reservation holder's reservation group will abide by the City's ratio: a maximum of three children under 8 years of age must be actively supervised in the pool (and on immediate deck and amenities) at all times by a responsible person 15 years of age or older (preferably a parent or guardian).
6. Reservation holder agrees and acknowledges that at all times, all users within the Reservation holder's reservation group will keep children under 8 years of age within ARM'S REACH at all times. Children under the age of 8 who are found to be not supervised will not be allowed in the pool.
7. Reservation holder will ensure that all users within the Reservation holder's reservation group will complete the City's swim test prior to entering deep water, each time the users visit the facility. Everyone must be able to swim 25 metres on their front without stopping before entering deep water (above chest deep). All youth under the age of 13 years must demonstrate (at each visit to the facility) this ability, and those 13 years or age or older may be asked. If a lifejacket or PFD is used for the demonstrated swim, it must always be worn in deep water.
8. Reservation holder will ensure that all of their users are aware of their limitations. The Reservation holder will ensure that all users are aware of deep areas. PFDs (lifejackets) are recommended for all weak or non-swimmers. PFDs are available at all pools free of charge.
9. Reservation holder will ensure that all of its users take a cleansing shower before every swim to avoid carrying dirt, bodily secretions, bacteria or residue from hygiene products into the pool.
10. Reservation holder will ensure that its users eat only in designated areas, and not on the pool deck.
11. Reservation holder will ensure that its users alert facility staff of any medical conditions or problems (ie: heart conditions, epilepsy etc.) of any of its users.
