In recent memory, when Ward 5 residents were asked to identify their concerns, the responses have been predominantly linked to transportation. Over the years, Council and City Administration have moved forward a number of priority issues in Southwest Edmonton connected to the movement of goods and people.

I would like to share with you some of the numbers gathered from the Transportation capital budget, spent over the last 3 years in Ward 5:

\$101,108,326 - Capital dollars spent on Ward 5 projects
 68.26 - Kilometres of road construction
 29,340 - Metres of curb and gutter replacement
 11,390 - Metres of sidewalk and multi-use trail construction
 302,050 - Number of potholes filled
\$19,000,000 - Capital dollars spent on LRT related projects
 19.31 - Kilometres of road replacement
 19.0 - Kilometres of maintenance paving
 21.3 - Kilometres of grind and repave

- Roads, curbs, gutters and sidewalks provided in new neighbourhood by developers, have not been included in the above numbers.
- The cost and information generated by the provincially designed, built and operated southwest Anthony Henday is not included in the above numbers.
- Capital and operating dollars spent expanding transit service in Ward 5 are not included in the above numbers.
