Adopt a Roadway Information Sheet

KEEPING EDMONTON CLEAN: What does it mean?

The Adopt a Roadway concept allows a group/company/family/individual to adopt a section of roadway by agreeing to pick the roadside litter at least twice a year (spring and prior to winter). The City of Edmonton will provide identification signs adjacent to the section of roadway to recognize the group/company/family/Individual's name. The participants will provide the labour service on a voluntary basis (no payments made by the City of Edmonton). Actual litter pick-up can be undertaken by a third part on your behalf.

ELIGIBILITY

Any group/company/family/individual is eligible. The City of Edmonton recommends a minimum of three people per kilometre adopted. All participants must be at least 10 years of age.

RESPONSIBILITIES

The City of Edmonton will provide recognition signs, safety training for the applicant(s), safety vests, litter bags and WCB volunteer coverage. The City of Edmonton will pick up the filled litter bags.

The applicant(s) will provide the participant labour services, hold safety training talks for participants, adhere to the Keeping Edmonton Clean guidelines and have valid Comprehensive General Liability Insurance coverage (optional).

DURATION

Adoption will be for a minimum of three years with a renewal option.
