



Key Features & Experiences:

- The addition of a Park “Hub” near the centre of the park that will provide a place to stop, meet, gather, & converse
- The concept identifies a community facility placeholder, future funding is required
- The concept identifies entry nodes that can be explored in the design phase to include opportunities for art, historical elements, sense of place, & wayfinding
- Majority of existing trees are maintained and upgraded by incorporating mulched beds and additional plant material. Some selective removal to facilitate trail and amenity development
- Pathway loops within the park of different lengths provide network for fitness, casual walks, and full accessibility
- Existing low spots and wet areas are repaired to improve open space use areas to include picnic tables for gathering
- The concept identifies community amenity areas that can be explored in the design phase to include opportunities for public art, seating, shelters, gathering spaces.
