Motion of Support with Conditions

As the project proceeds, the Committee recommends the following be considered:

- As the fine-grained road network described in the presentation was not apparent in package, ensure the development of clear policy direction to achieve this intention.
- Converting 118 Avenue at Coliseum Station to an at-grade crossing to improve the urban design condition and reinforce a connected and cohesive development.
- In line with the guiding principles, more clearly articulate the essence, character and general vision of this development and how it is visually communicated in the planning framework (eg. through typical sections, typologies, precedent images, etc).
- Explore the opportunity for north-south open space connectivity between Borden Park and the North Transit Village.

The Committee recommends the Applicant work with Administration on the following:

- Refining the proposed landscape treatment along Gateway Boulevard. More thought should be given to framing the development, while ensuring appropriate species selection in terms of size/ spread (at maturity) and hardiness.
- Addressing the likelihood that the noise attenuation fence along the east property boundary will create a CPTED issue. At a minimum, the Committee recommends limiting access to this area and increasing lighting.

- Resolving off-site improvements (related to landscaping and streetscaping) and community amenity contribution (related to the proposed pocket park).
