Event Date Booking requests: Application Information

ECSC Policy #6 provides the guidelines for approving dates for Combative Sports Events. To ensure a qualified level of service can be provided, only one event is allowed on a particular date. The City of Edmonton accepts requests for event dates in advance, and evaluates each request within 2 weeks of submission.

Event Date Booking Request:

- 1. Applicant must hold a valid promoter's licence for the year of the dates requested.
- 2. On an annual basis, the Executive Director will ask promoters to submit their event requests for the following year, on the event date request forms.
- 3. Requests are evaluated and a decision will be provided within two weeks of submission.
- 4. In determining the priority of each request, or if there are competing requests for the same date, the Executive Director may consider the following criteria:
 - a. Availability of licensed officials
 - b. Television coverage that is only available on a particular date
 - c. The event is part of a series of events that is linked to a television contract
 - d. The date in question is a date the promoter usually requests
 - e. Expected live spectator audience
 - f. Number of events already held by that promoter in that quarter.

Event Date Application Requirements:

- 1. Promoter name and Company
- 2. Type of Event & Anticipated number of bouts
- 3. \$1,000 deposit for each date requested. \$500 is returned back to the promoter if the event is held on the date in question.
