

# Stay safe around LRT!

The ETS TraXSafe program helps transit customers and pedestrians stay safe around LRT tracks and stations.

## Follow these TraXSafe Tips to stay safe around LRT

1. Always obey signs and signals
2. Always cross at designated safe crossings
3. Always look both ways before crossing
4. Never stop on the tracks
5. Don't play on or near the tracks
6. Don't put anything on the tracks
7. Be careful when crossing the tracks
8. Never try to race a train
9. Stand back from platform edges
10. Listen for station or train announcements

# Follow these tips to stay safe around LRT

## Stay safe around LRT tracks

- Cross only at marked crossing areas and NEVER walk along tracks.
- STOP, LOOK in both directions, and LISTEN before crossing the tracks.
- Obey all signs, signals, and announcements.
- DO NOT enter track areas when crossing arms are down, lights and bells are activated or when the train is approaching.



LRT underpasses, overpasses and platforms are monitored by security cameras.



Help phones are available in all LRT and Transit Centres



## LRT trains are fast and quiet and can come from either direction on any track.

## Stay safe on LRT platforms

- Stand back from platform edges behind yellow line when waiting for LRT.
- Pay attention to announcements.
- Platforms are monitored by security cameras and help phones are available.



Where available, pedestrians should use pedestrian underpasses or overpasses at LRT stations.

- Be courteous to others and don't play, loiter in or block walkways.

## Pedestrian crossing restrictions

Some intersections have pedestrian crossing restrictions.

Pedestrians must only cross in direction permitted.
