

ETS Travel Training Mobility Choices

ETS provides a free, customized travel training program for seniors, persons with disabilities, and those who work with persons with mobility challenges. The Mobility Choices travel training program teaches persons with mobility and cognitive disabilities the skills they need to make full use of our accessible public transit system and also provides an overview of ETS's complete range of accessible services, including Disabled Adult Transit Service (DATS).

Information and training sessions can be provided on either a group or individual basis, and are designed to be as flexible as possible in order to accommodate the needs and abilities of the participants. Group sessions include general or more specific information on ETS services and programs, whereas individual sessions generally take the form of accompanied travel training ("bus buddy") and individualized instruction on the transit system. All training and information components of this program are offered free of charge.

Mobility Choices training modules include

- an overview of the local public transit system
- step-by-step instructions for accessing transit information, boarding, exiting and securement on accessible vehicles (buses and LRT, DATS);
- safety and security features; as well as an opportunity to board and ride on ETS' accessible vehicles with their mobility equipment.
