## Grandview Heights River Valley **Stairs Rehabilitation**

**The Grandview Heights stairs** are part of the City's river valley stairs program that include four other sets of stairs. The Grandview Heights stairs have been designed using a similar design for consistency amongst all five stairs.

## What Has Already Been Decided

- + LOCATION The stairs will be re-built in the same location.
- + STYLE The stairs will be re-built in a similar style that currently exists.
- + PITCH/SLOPE The pitch/slope will be the same.
- WIDTH The stairs will be approximately 20% wider. The goal is to fit three people across.
- TREAD/RUN (the horizontal portion of the stairs that people walk/run on) – Current City standards are 12" to 16". The tread/run of the stairs will be consistent and will meet these standards.

• RISE (the distance between stairs vertically) – Current City standards are 6" to 8". The rise of the stairs will be consistent and will meet these standards.

## What Needs To Be Decided

 NUMBER OF LANDINGS – The two concept designs designate a different number of landings in each design.
