

Gazebos are \$37.95 per hour. There is a 2 hour minimum for each reservation.

Note:

Park staff will post signage at the gazebo up to half an hour prior to your start time on the day of your reservation. This lets other park users know that you have reserved the gazebo. A member of your group may wish to arrive 15 minutes prior to your event starting. Do not leave any items unattended.

Reservation Instructions

To reserve the Dr Wilbert McIntyre Gazebo, the Grant Notley Gazebo, or the Dick Mather Gazebo:

Online Request: Submit an online request and have a booking agent review your request and answer your questions to help reserve the location that is going to best suit your needs.

For all other City of Edmonton Park Gazebos you may need to speak to a Community Recreation Coordinator in order to permit your event. Please contact 311 to be connected with the CRC for the park you are interested in.

Power &

Power is available at Grant Notley Gazebo and Dr Wilbert McIntyre Gazebo. Power access if required, must be requested and paid for a minimum of 14 business days prior to your event. The outlets can accommodate two (2) small appliances. The power access fee is \$45.90 per site.



Liquor is not permitted in public areas this includes all City Parks.



Barbeques, hot plates, and open flame equipment are not permitted within the gazebo structure.

Dogs & Pets

Dogs are not permitted within 10 meters of any gazebo. All other pets are not permitted on City Parkland.

Garbage & Waste

There are multiple garbage receptacles located throughout the park near each of the gazebos. The permit holder is responsible for ensuring all garbage has been collected and properly disposed of.



Parking

Parking is very limited at all venues.
