

Scramble Intersections in Edmonton

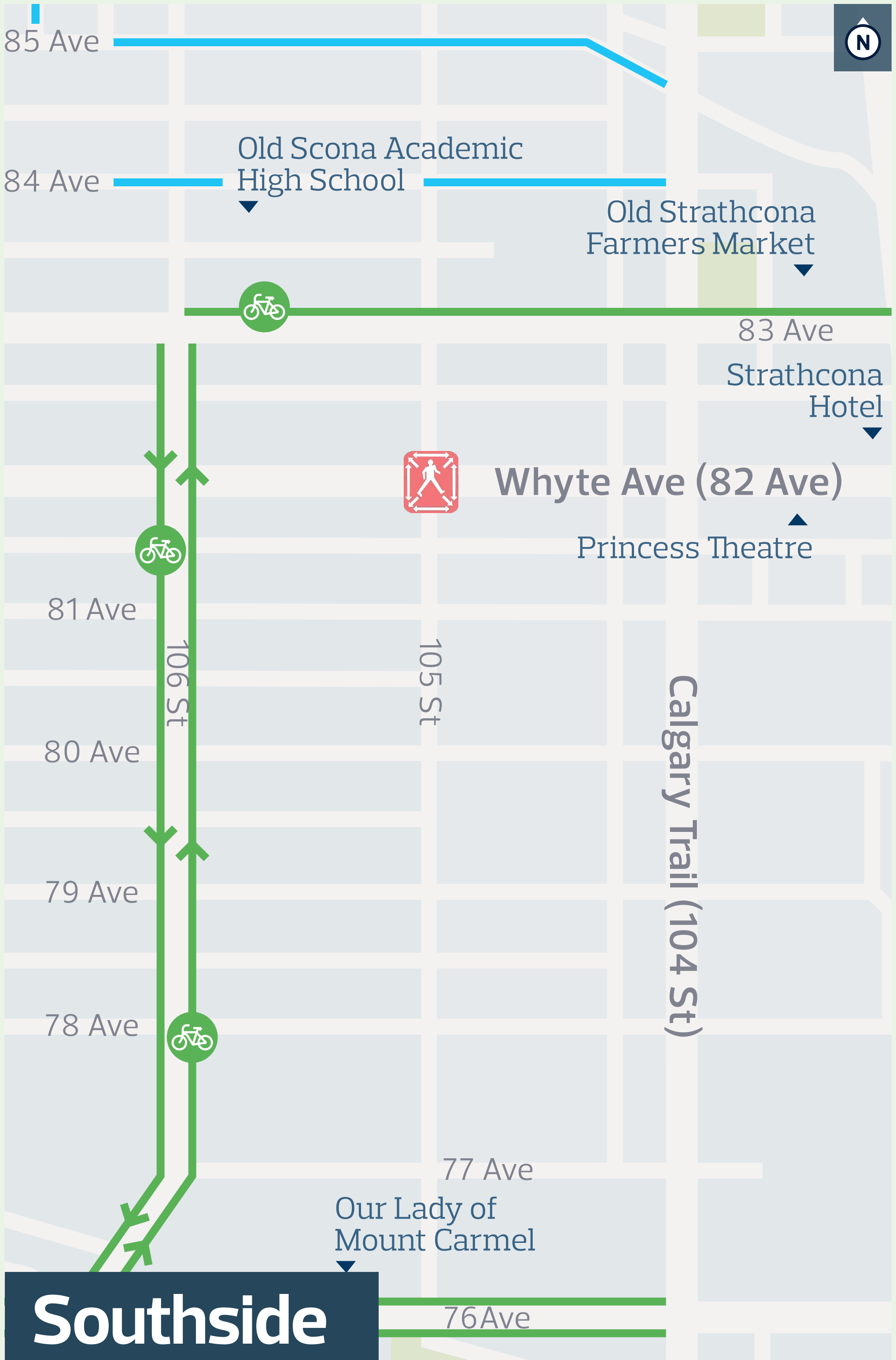
Five (5) Pedestrian scramble intersections have been installed in Edmonton.

The scramble intersections at Jasper Avenue and 104 Street and at Whyte Avenue and 105 Street are part of a pilot project. They are being closely monitored for traffic flow, infractions, and rates of collisions.

The scramble intersections in the Ice District (104 Avenue and 104 Street, 104 Avenue and 102 Street, 103 Avenue and 103 Street) are permanent. Edmonton Police Service may manually operate these intersections with uniformed traffic officers during large events.
