

## 107 Avenue Revitalization: 101 Street to 121 Street

---

As part of the 2024 construction program, City of Edmonton, Integrated Infrastructure Services will be involved in construction on 107 Avenue 101 Street to 121 Street.

107 Avenue will have new street lights installed which includes new pieces of concrete walk around the new street light poles. New street enhancements include new pavers, bike racks and benches. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained in both directions on 107 Avenue during construction with intermittent lane closures putting 107 Avenue down to one lane in each direction.

**Work is scheduled to start on or about August 12, 2024 and is scheduled to be completed by the end of July of 2025.**

### Scope of Work

- New street light poles.
- Removals and replacement of pieces of the existing sidewalk at new poles.
- New paving stones.
- New bike racks and benches.

### Access

During the construction period, local access will be maintained at all times. Access to businesses and residences will be maintained, where possible, at all times. Emergency access will be Maintained at all times.

## **107 Ave Park:**

As part of the 107 Avenue Revitalization Project, a new public park will be constructed in 2024 at the southeast corner of 107 Avenue and 105 Street. This scope includes a central plaza, a raised stage, landscaping, a shelter, pedestrian-scale lights, seating areas and a water bottle filling station. The northbound 105 Street right-hand turn lane will be closed to expand the usable park area.
