

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Capital Line South LRT Utility Relocation Project 111 Street Between 12 Avenue and 23 Avenue NW

MAY 2023

PROJECT OVERVIEW

As part of the Capital Line South LRT Extension Project, EPCOR is responsible for relocating all the power, water and drainage utilities to avoid potential conflicts with the future Capital Line South LRT extension infrastructure. This is an extension of the current Capital Line, which will operate from Century Park to Ellerslie Road. The Capital Line South LRT Relocation Project began in May 2023 and is expected to be completed by the end of the year.

WHAT'S HAPPENING?

To meet the overall LRT project schedule, the City of Edmonton has requested that EPCOR perform the utility relocations within specific areas along the alignment prior to LRT construction.

New drainage infrastructure will be installed and relocated along 111 Street south of 23 Avenue to 12 Avenue NW beginning in June 2023.

SCHEDULE

There are four stages of the drainage work:

Stage One – Storm relocation on the west side of 111 Street between 19 Avenue and 23 Avenue NW

- Expected to begin in **early June 2023** and anticipated to be completed by **early August**
- Construction will involve work further outlined in this notice

Stage Two – Sanitary relocation on the west side of 111 Street, north of Blackmud Creek

- Expected to begin in **mid-July 2023** and anticipated to be completed by **early August 2023**

Stage Three – Outfall & storm line relocation in Blackmud Creek

- Expected to begin in **late June 2023** and anticipated to be completed by **December 2023**

Stage Four – Sanitary relocation south of Blackmud Creek

- Expected to begin on in **early August 2023** and anticipated to be completed by **early September 2023**

Timelines are estimates and may change based on weather and construction conditions.


More information, including traffic impacts and timelines on remaining stages, will be shared with residents adjacent to the work areas prior to work starting.

HOURS OF WORK

Regular working hours are **7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Monday to Saturday**. If required, these hours may be extended, and construction may occur on **Sundays from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.**


EPCOR will do everything possible to manage noise associated with the construction and will work to ensure that the construction is completed within the requirements of the City of Edmonton Noise Bylaw.

MAP OF STAGE ONE WORK AREA

Expected to begin in **early June 2023** and anticipated to be completed by **mid-August 2023**. Please note, the centre median will be removed prior to construction to accommodate extra traffic lanes. *Timelines are estimates and may change based on weather and construction conditions.*



TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Two southbound lanes will be closed on 111 Street between 23 Avenue and 19 Avenue. The centre median will be removed prior to construction to allow two lanes in each direction.
- No left hand turns will be permitted at the following:
 - From southbound 111 Street into the Heritage Village Shopping Centre parking lot, Bears paw Drive and the YMCA parking lot.
 - From the Heritage Village Shopping Centre parking lot, Bears paw Drive and the YMCA parking lot onto southbound 111 Street.

SAFETY

The construction area will be fenced and/or marked as a restricted area. We will take every precaution to ensure public safety, and we request your assistance in keeping children and pets a safe distance from the construction site and the equipment.

We thank you for your patience and understanding as we perform this necessary work.

OTHER WORK IN THE AREA

EPCOR Water

Water utility locations will occur along 111 Street both north and south of 23 Avenue. Work will include moving a water transmission main to the east side of 111 Street. Work will begin as early as **June 2023** and will take approximately **two months** to complete.

EPCOR Power

Starting in late May, for approximately three months, EPCOR will be working along 111 Street from 19 Avenue NW to 25 Avenue NW to relocate electricity infrastructure.

Work will include excavating in certain locations and using a horizontal directional drill to install new underground power cables between sites. Open cut trenching is required to relocate power lines within the east side of 111 Street NW at 25 Avenue NW.

Temporary road/lane and sidewalk restrictions are expected along the east side of 111 Street NW from 19 Avenue NW to 25 Avenue NW. Signage will indicate traffic detours as required.

Power outages may be necessary at times to ensure work can be completed safely. Customers can learn more about power outages at epcor.com/poweroutages.
