While the purpose of the proposal is for the land to remain agricultural, permitting a subdivision on this parcel would contribute to fragmentation.
- 2. City Plan identifies this parcel as within a Future Growth Area. "Future Growth Area includes lands for agricultural preservation as well as future potential for residential and nonresidential growth. This area is located south of 41 Avenue SW and will require the authorization and preparation of new geographic plans before development is allowed." As no geographic plan exists, allowance of a subdivision would be premature.
- 3. The proposed subdivision does not meet the 'General Purpose' statement for the (AES) Agricultural Edmonton South Zone, which states: "New Residential Lots created after passage of this Bylaw shall only be created to subdivide a farmstead from a previously unsubdivided quarter section, and shall be no larger than 2.0 ha (4.9 ac)." In this regard, this quarter-section has previously been subdivided once already (i.e. creating two existing parcels). If approved, this subdivision application would result in a combined total of three parcels on this quarter-section.
- 4. The proposed subdivision does not comply with the minimum development regulation of the AES Zone identified in Section 1000.9(4)(a) of the City of Edmonton Zoning Bylaw 12800. The minimum Lot size identified in the (AES) Zone is 32.4 ha. The size of the proposed lots is 16.2 ha and is therefore deficient by 16.2 ha or 50%.


LOT 22 AND EAST 1/2 OF LOT 21 **BLK.2, PLAN 2000U**


