81 Avenue Reconstruction and Streetscaping

The City of Edmonton will reconstruct 81 Avenue from Gateway Boulevard to 104 Street and add streetscape features such as paving stones, street furniture, trees and decorative lighting. This project will create a vibrant pedestrian-first corridor and improve road safety for all users. A pedestrian-first corridor is a designated and marked area where pedestrians can safely cross. Corridors prioritize pedestrians and aim to encourage walking by providing safe crossing opportunities. **Construction is planned to begin the week of April 28, 2025. Construction is anticipated to be completed by the end of 2025.**

Construction Details

- Removal of existing sidewalk and road
- Concrete work including new curbs, gutters and sidewalks
- Upgrading pedestrian crossings, pedestrian lighting and street lighting
- Road reconstruction including new asphalt and paving
- Landscaping

Directional closures on 81 Avenue will be in place during construction. Pedestrian, local and business access will be maintained at all times, where possible. If you have special access requirements, such as DATS, please advise the contact person listed below.
