  - Pros: better stability for the Executive and would provide more time to accomplish goals.
     Executive could plan for the upcoming year in the summer.
  - Cons: CEYC has a high turnover rate and is unpredictable due to the age of the committee members. This may prove to be a barrier for participation and not allow new members opportunities.
