No Symptoms	Positive A positive test is:		 Call your leader to report a positive test. Stay home for 5 days; or if you develop symptoms stay home until symptoms have improved and you remain fever-free for at least 24 hours, whichever is longer. For up to 5 days following your period of sick leave (10 days total) you must wear a mask at all times when around others at work. This means you should eat or drink alone, away from others.

Time entry: All sick absences are managed through short-term disability benefits, processes and reporting. As per usual short term disability claims, supervisors are responsible for approving the first 5 days of absence; thereafter, the employee must apply for benefits through Disability Management. All employees are entitled up to 3 hours to attend appointments for vaccinations. MDL for permanent employees, LWP for temporary employees.

Leaders must use the <u>COVID-19 intake form</u> to report an employee's positive COVID-19 test.

When can you return to work?

Symptoms start or positive COVID-19 test (Day 0)

Sick day 1, 2, 3, 4, 5

Can return to work (Day 6)
