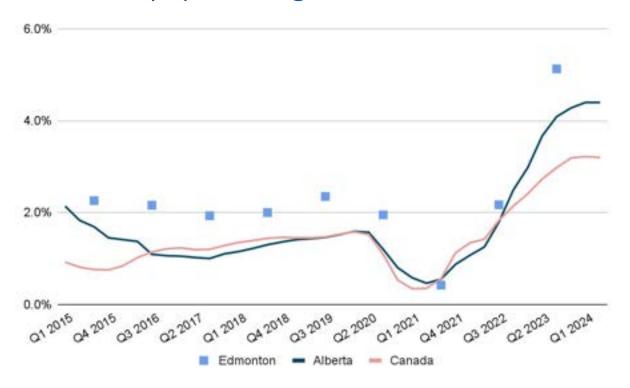

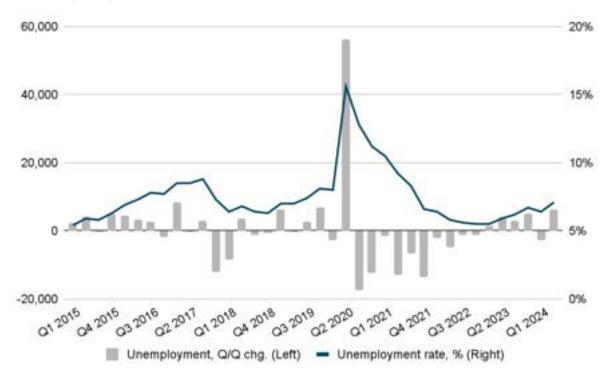
Annualized population growth

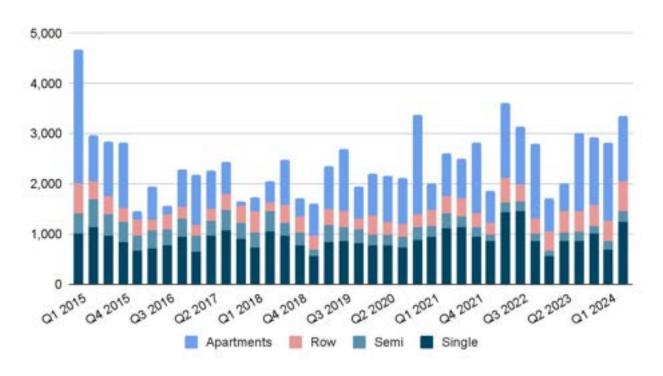
Unemployment - Edmonton CMA

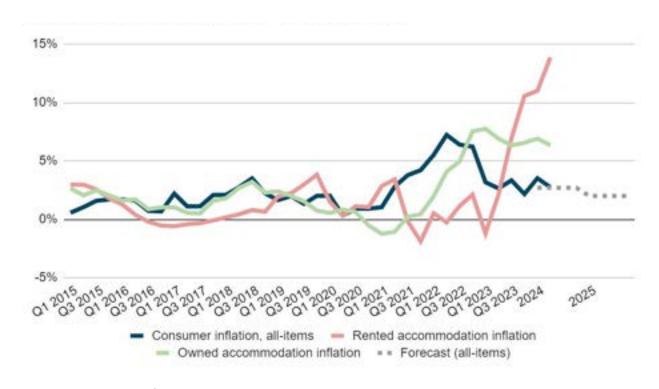
Housing starts composition - Edmonton

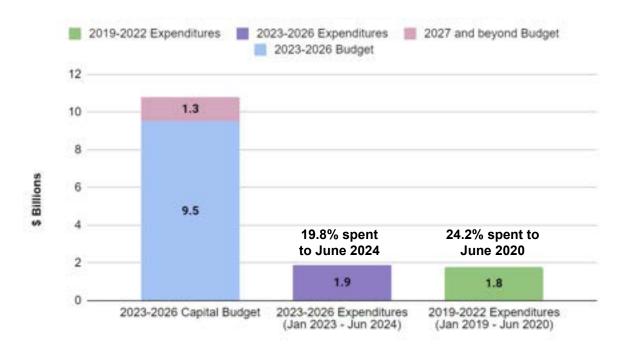

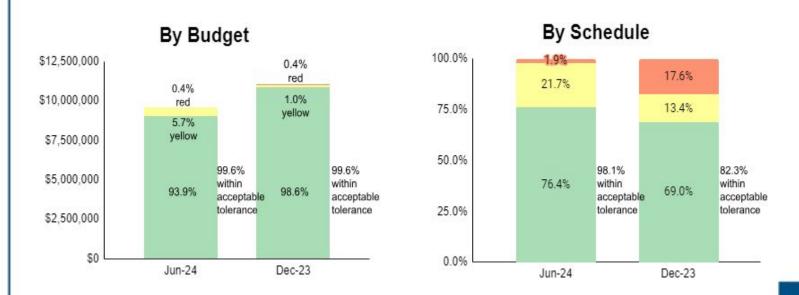
Budget Cycle Spend

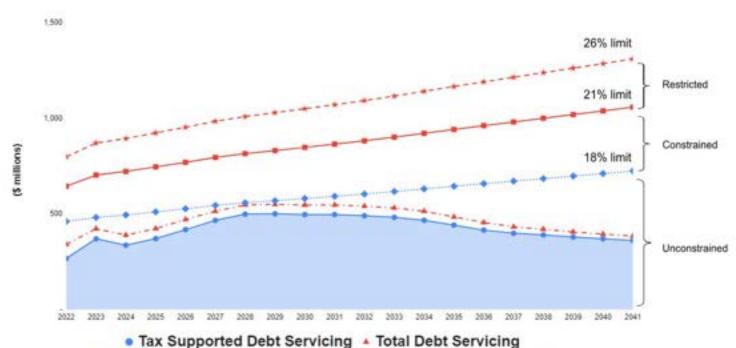

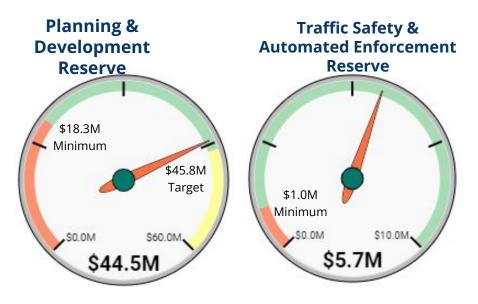

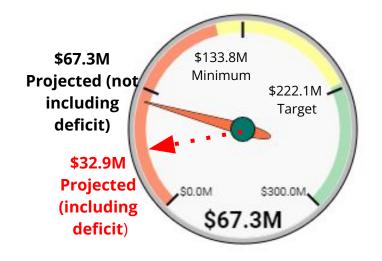

Reserve Update (\$M) Financial Stabilization Posony

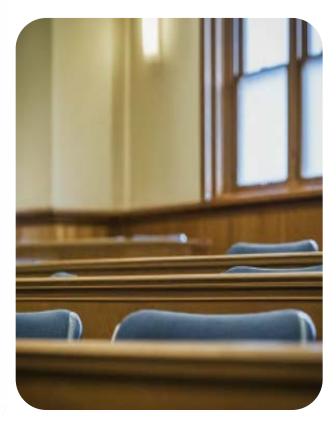
Financial Stabilization Reserve (Unappropriated)
