# PROJECT UPDATE 

Latta Bridge Replacement: Jasper Avenue, 90 Street to 91 Street

The City of Edmonton would like to thank you for your patience and cooperation as we continue to work on the Latta Bridge replacement. The replacement and roadway improvements began in August 2022. Since construction began, the project team has implemented temporary speed bumps along 105A Avenue and 106 Avenue, provided signage for businesses in the area, and installed new speed and hidden driveway signage in the alleyway. The project team has also worked with Edmonton Police Service and St. Teresa School, along with residents to address concerns about shortcutting and speed in the project area.

## Project Update

As work progresses, access to 91 Street from Jasper Avenue will be restricted. Local residential traffic can access the alleyway from 90 Street until project completion. The planned closure is scheduled for the week of February 13, 2023.

Construction on the Kinnard Bridge, located on 82 Street between 112 Avenue and Jasper Avenue, will begin in the spring. One lane of traffic in both directions and one sidewalk will remain open whenever possible. Alternative routes for pedestrians, cyclists, motorists and transit will be shared closer to construction dates on edmonton.ca/KinnairdBridge

## Access

During the construction project, detours will be maintained to divert non-residential traffic. 91 Street will remain open for residential traffic until the week of February 13. After the closure begins, only residential vehicle traffic will have access to alleys in the surrounding area. Additional signage will be placed. Affected location(s) are marked on the back of this bulletin.
