

EDGEMONT COMMUNITY PARK

June 2025

The City of Edmonton is working to ensure all Edmontonians have safe access to recreation and green spaces. To support this, and prepare for a new Kindergarten to Grade 9 school, the City is building a new community park in the Edgemont neighbourhood.

Project overview

The City of Edmonton will bring Edgemont Community Park to a base level of development. This includes grading, planting grass and landscaping, as well as developing sports fields, adding park furniture and new shared pathways.

The final design is available at edmonton.ca/EdgemontPark. It includes a baseball diamond, two soccer fields and a new playground. The City will also build pathways and seating areas and will install new lighting. The existing playground and natural area will remain.

Construction impacts

Construction is anticipated to begin in early July. Short closures of the existing trail northeast of the park will be necessary during construction. Temporary signage will be put up to direct users to a detour. While there are no plans to close the existing playground during construction, unplanned, short-term impacts may occur.

Residents in the neighbourhood may experience increased noise levels and traffic around the area. All construction will take place during the hours of 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday to Saturday, according to the Community Standards Bylaw. The site will be fenced off and construction equipment and materials will be stored near the work area.
