B. OTHER BUSINESS

B.1. 2024-25 Work Plan Update; Committee discussion of What We Did Report

Standard and Procedures (Appendix A):

- Potential exemption of informal projects:
 - J. Monfries requested that the terminology "satisfactorily resolved" be clarified. D. Brown replaced "satisfactorily resolved" with "meets the criteria of the submission guide"
 - D. Brown reminded the Committee that exempting formal presentations was envisioned as a means of creating incentive to see more informal projects being reviewed. This process should be viewed using the future criteria (submission guide) and not the existing criteria.
 - P. Spearey informed the Committee that if we were to proceed with the exemption of formal presentations, the applicant would have to make their informal presentation in public, and Administration would need to draft a procedure for this process.
 - N. LaMontagne suggested having three types of motions for informals: 1) Motion of Support (exempted from formal review), 2) Support with Considerations (generally supported by the Committee, but there are still

items that would need to be resolved at a formal), 3) Non-support (project requires a complete redesign).

• D. Brown highlighted the importance of maintaining consistency in the pattern of motioning at both formals and informals (i.e. only two options: support or non-support, based on whether or not the presentation meets the criteria outlined in the submission guide). This will help make the process clear for applicants as well as EDC members.

Submission Guide (Appendix B):

• J. Monfries suggested the term "narrative" be replaced to better indicate the importance of providing detailed drawings, rather than long written descriptions.

Scope/EDC Boundary (Appendix C):

• No additional comments to resolve.

- Based on this feedback, Administration will complete all suggested edits, per Committee feedback, no later than Thursday October 31, 2024.
- The EDC engagement survey will be made public on Monday November 4, 2024. Action: The Committee is encouraged to share this information with their industry contacts for feedback. Links to the survey can be found on the <u>EDC</u> <u>website</u>.
