You will have to serve a waiting period during which no benefits can be paid. As a result of legislative changes effective January 1, 2017, the waiting period is one week for claims starting on that date or later. For claims starting prior to January 1, 2017, the waiting period remains at two weeks.

It is important that you file your reports. If you do not and your situation changes, you could lose benefits.
