Southbound Low Level Bridge Rehabilitation

The southbound Low Level Bridge is being rehabilitated to extend the bridge lifespan and ensure the crossing remains safe and reliable until the bridge can be decommissioned. **Construction is expected to begin the week of July 28 and be completed by the end of 2025.**

Construction Details

- A temporary crossover will be built to shift southbound traffic to the northbound Low Level Bridge
- Scaffolding and other site preparation
- Bridge cleaning
- Replacing and strengthening select bridge components

Traffic Impacts

- Starting July 28, there will be no northbound traffic on Low Level Bridge. Northbound traffic will be detoured to the James MacDonald Bridge.
- There will be temporary single-lane closures on the southbound Low Level Bridge during off-peak hours. Two-lane traffic will remain during afternoon peak traffic hours. Some full overnight closures of the southbound bridge will be required.
- In early mid-August, once the crossover is complete, southbound traffic will shift to the northbound Low Level Bridge. Two lanes of southbound traffic will resume for the duration of construction. **Please follow the signage in the area.**
- Right turns from 99A Street onto Scona Road will be closed for the duration of the project
- Some night work will take place to reduce daytime traffic disruptions
- Two ETS bus stops that service northbound traffic on the Low Level Bridge will be temporarily closed: McDougall Hill & Grierson Hill (Stop ID: 1190) and Low Level Bridge & 98 Avenue (Stop ID: 2134). To plan your trip, use tripplanner.edmonton.ca
- Pedestrian access will be maintained on the northbound bridge and the shared pathway below the bridge.

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


Image 1 – Traffic map for upcoming Low Level Bridge Rehabilitation
