

## Mackinnon Ravine Pedestrian Bridge Construction

The City of Edmonton and Alberco Construction Ltd. will begin construction on the replacement of the Mackinnon Ravine Pedestrian Bridge located along 148 Street between Stony Plain Road and Summit Drive. The previous structure was closed to the public in late 2021 and demolished in early 2022 due to concerns regarding the structure's capacity to hold snow removal equipment safely. Construction starting on the bridge's north end is **scheduled to begin the week of July 17**. **Starting in early August, a single-lane closure will occur along Summit Drive** to accommodate construction on the bridge's south end.

### Scope of Work

- A replacement bridge will be constructed in the same location as the previous structure.
- The replacement bridge will be built to meet current City standards. The bridge will be wider than the original for functionality and safety of all users.
- Repaving of the shared pathway.
- New trees will be planted as part of the project. Natural areas disturbed by construction will be restored.

### Access

An easily accessible alternative path connecting Summit Drive to Stony Plain Road is located along 149 Street. During the construction period, detours will be maintained to divert traffic. Please see the map below for further details.




Image 1 - MacKinnon Ravine Pedestrian Bridge Replacement Construction Area
