The subdivision was initially approved on May 1, 2014. The first Change Request to adjust the boundary between Phases 1 and 2 was approved April 15, 2021. This second Change Request breaks the subdivision into 5 phases, revises the shape and size of a Municipal Reserve Lot, changes the local road pattern in Phase 5, and reduces the number of residential lots.

The Subdivision by Plan is APPROVED on November 27, 2025, subject to the following conditions:

- that the owner dedicate Municipal Reserve (MR) as 8.80 ha and 0.18 ha lots, pursuant to Section 666 of the Municipal Government Act as shown on the "Conditions of Approval" map, Enclosure I;

- 4. that the subdivision Phase 1 boundary be amended to include the dedication of the full intersection of Crystallina Nera Drive NW and 72 St NW, to the satisfaction of Subdivision and Development Coordination, as shown on the "Conditions of Approval" map, Enclosure I;

- 14. that the owner pay for the installation of Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon, as shown on the "Conditions of Approval" map, Enclosure I. The City of Edmonton shall complete the signal design, and the City's Electrical Services Contractor must install the traffic control device as per the agreement between the City of Edmonton and the Electrical Services Contractor. The timing of the traffic control device installation will be at the direction of City Operations. If traffic signals are not deemed warranted by City Operations within 5 years of signing the Servicing Agreement, the owner will be required to provide payment to the City of Edmonton for the installation of traffic signals at that time to fulfill this obligation;
- 15. that the owner provide full site servicing for the 8.80 ha MR lot including, two 3-phase power, water, sanitary and storm services, to the satisfaction of all affected Departments and agencies;
- 16. that the owner construct all fences wholly on privately-owned land and the Municipal Reserve (MR) lot, to the satisfaction of Subdivision and Development Coordination, as shown on the "Conditions of Approval" map, Enclosure I;
- 17. that the owner provide naturalization landscaping within the MR parcel, to the satisfaction of City Departments and affected utility agencies, as generally shown on the "Conditions of Approval" map, Enclosure I; and
- 18. that the owner is responsible for the landscape design and construction within the Municipal Reserve lots, walkway, and road rights of way to the satisfaction of City Departments and affected utility agencies.

Municipal Reserve (MR) for Lot 1, Block 1, Plan 1123855 were previously addressed with SUB/04-0022 by registering a 9.125 ha Deferred Reserve Caveat (DRC). The DRC was reduced by 0.505 ha as per LDA11-0321 to 8.62 ha. No information is available on why the DRC was reduced but all internal files and notes reference the lower value of 8.62 ha.

The 8.62 ha DRC was further reduced by 1.32 ha with LDA11-0321 to dedicate a park parcel. LDA12-0414 further reduced the DRC by dedicating a 0.56 ha and 0.73 ha park parcels and balance of 5.91 ha carried forward on title. The DRC will be discharged in full with LDA13-0553 to dedicate 5.91 ha which is part of the 8.80 ha school park site.

MR for Lot 4, Block 1, Plan 2122367 were previously addressed with LDA16-0553 by registering a 6.55 ha DRC. The DRC was reduced by 1.92 ha and 0.26 ha with LDA16-0553 to dedicate two park parcels and a balance of 4. 37 ha carried forward on the title. The DRC will be partially discharged to dedicate 2.89 ha which is part of the 8.80 ha school park site and 0.18 ha park greenway parcel. 1 The balance of 1.3 ha will be carried forward on title for future assembly of 0.66 ha park parcel and money in lieu.





Next Steps for Subdivision Approval

• The next step in the subdivision process is to have a legal instrument prepared (ie. Plan of Survey) in order to register the approved subdivision. The legal instrument is then forwarded to the City for endorsement along with the endorsement fee (\$730.00 - 2025 Fees Schedule) and subsequently released to the applicant for registration at the Land Titles Office.

Transportation

- There are existing boulevard trees adjacent to the site that must be protected during construction. For information about tree protection please refer to the City of Edmonton's website (search "Trees and Construction").
- Any and all costs associated with tree work requests (removal, pruning or other) and/or remediation from damages are borne on to the proponent as per the Corporate Tree Management Policy (C456C). All work is to be carried out by Urban Forestry who can be contacted at citytrees@edmonton.ca. Removal of City of Edmonton trees must follow the Live Tree Removal Guidelines which include community notice and value compensation.
- Access for future development must be to the adjacent alley as per the General Regulations (Section 6.1) in the 2.10 RS Small Scale Residential Zone of Zoning Bylaw 20001.
- There is an existing access to 58 Street NW. Upon redevelopment of proposed Lot 19A, it must be removed. At that time, the owner/applicant will be required to obtain a Permit for the access' removal from the City's Development Services team. Apply online at www.edmonton.ca/permits.
- There are existing concrete steps that encroach into the 58 Street NW road right of way. They must be removed or the owner must enter into an Encroachment Agreement with the City of Edmonton. Email encroachmentagreements@edmonton.ca for information.

Building / Site

• The owner shall ensure that any change in property boundaries does not cause any structures on site to become non-compliant with the Safety Codes Act and the Alberta Building Code. Permits may be required for such changes. Please contact 311 for more information.

Servicing

- The owner is required to make satisfactory arrangements for, and pay all costs associated with separate servicing to each lot, as well as the modification, relocation and/or removal of existing services. For further information, please contact: EPCOR Distribution & Transmission Inc. (780-412-4000), TELUS Communications (Edmonton) Inc. (Real Estate Division [Rights of Way] 780-508-2456), ATCO Gas (780-424-5222), and EPCOR Drainage Services (Infill Water and Sewer Servicing 780-496-5444).
- The existing services (water and sanitary) enter the proposed subdivision off the lane west of 58
 Street, at 23.77 m north of the north property line of the lane south of 119 Avenue NW. As per
 the EPCOR Drainage Services Bylaw and the EPCOR Water Services and Wastewater Treatment
 Bylaw, these services cannot cross the proposed property line.

- There is a deficiency in on-street hydrant spacing adjacent to the property. The applicant/owner
 is advised to review on-site fire protection requirements to ensure adequate coverage (contact
 EPCOR Water at 780-412-3955).
- There is an existing power pole and guy wire that may interfere with access to proposed Lot 19B.




