The Development Services Branch has updated the Guidelines for Arterial Construction, which have been circulated with industry members for feedback, prepared updates to Bylaw 14380 – Arterial Roads for Development which they will bring to Council for approval in quarter 3 of 2023 and created a new Arterial Road Assessment Standard. Our review of the documents provided by Development Services indicate that they have addressed the conditions that gave rise to the initial audit recommendation.

The Development Services Branch has created a new Arterial Roadway Assessment (ARA) Procedure Manual, outlining both the methodology used in calculating ARA amounts as well as the logic or rationale for how they make certain calculations. The Branch also created a manual for reviewing ARA rate calculations, which sets the expectations around the review process. These documents address the opportunities for improvement that were identified in the audit.

The Planning and Environmental Services Branch has developed standard operating procedures for the post-rehabilitation conduction assessment of historical resources. These procedures include risk based inspection categories to determine the order of condition assessments. These procedures formalize the approach to assess the ongoing condition of historic resources after the completion of grant-related rehabilitation work and help identify potential remediation actions. We have reviewed the draft documents but still need to conduct a final review. The draft documents are currently being reviewed by Branch staff and management for their approval.
