Alley renewal includes:

+ Reconstructing your alley with a new base and hard surface

Edmonton

- + Improving surface drainage, where possible
- + Pruning trees/shrubs as necessary ahead of construction
- + Replacing material between the alley and property line with the same material that was removed during construction

In addition, the design also includes

- + Minor widening to improve turning movements (where space allows)
- + Protective wooden posts to clearly identify alley driving spaces


Construction

Alley renewal construction will take place from May to October in 2023 and 2024.

Once construction starts in your alley, it will not be accessible for about four weeks. During this time, parking and waste collection will move to the front street.


