



Changes to ETS Route 614 Affecting Archbishop O'Leary, St. Cecilia, Killarney and Queen Elizabeth Schools

In response to changing ridership, route 614 will be rerouted through the Griesbach, Beaumaris, Lorelei, and Baturyn neighbourhoods. The route will continue to stop at O'Leary, St. Cecilia, Killarney and Queen Elizabeth schools.

We apologize for any inconvenience this route change may cause. However, this area continues to be served by several school and regular service ETS routes. For students travelling along 97 Street, route 130X may be an option.

Frequently Asked Questions

How does ETS decide which routes get changed?

ETS takes a data-driven approach to putting resources where they are needed most. Service changes are made based on data like on-time performance, rider numbers and crowding.

How do I find out which new route to take?

You can easily find your route by using the trip planner at edmonton.ca/Transit, or Google Maps' "public transport" option.

Can I still use my school board Arc card?

You can still use your school-issued Arc card—and benefit from the reduced fare cap—on regular service buses and LRT.
