

Changes to ETS Route 620 Affecting Londonderry School

Due to low ridership, the route 620 trip departing West Clareview Transit Centre at 7:44 a.m. (timed for the Londonderry School bell time) will be cancelled as of the end of June 2025. For an updated route brochure, please watch edmonton.ca/SchoolSpecialBusRoutes in August.

Route 620 will be rerouted to better serve the Matt Berry, Hollick Kenyon, and Brintnell neighbourhoods.

Route 620 will continue to run three times in the morning and three times in the afternoon.

Frequently Asked Questions

How does ETS decide which routes get changed or cancelled?

ETS takes a data-driven approach to putting resources where

they are needed most. Service changes are made based on data like on-time performance, rider numbers and crowding.

How do I find out which new route to take?

You can easily find your route by using the trip planner at edmonton.ca/Transit, or Google Maps' "public transport" option.

Can I still use my school board Arc card?

You can still use your school-issued Arc card—and benefit from the reduced fare cap—on regular service buses and LRT.
