

Changes to ETS Route 632 Affecting Austin O'Brien and Ottewell Schools

Frequently Asked Questions

How does ETS decide which trips get cancelled?

ETS takes a data-driven approach to putting resources where they are needed most. Service changes are made based on data like on-time performance, rider numbers and crowding. Taking transit is

How do I find out which new route to take?

You can easily find your route by using the trip planner at edmonton.ca/Transit, or Google Maps' "public transport" option.

Can I still use my school board Arc card?

You can still use your school-issued Arc card—and benefit from the reduced fare cap—on regular service buses and LRT.
