**NOTES TO OWNER/AGENT:**

- After an inspector has conducted an initial inspection of a new elevator, escalator, dumbwaiter, moving walk, freight platform, lift, passenger ropeway, handicapped lift, personnel hoist or manlift, and it has been found acceptable for operation, a temporary PERMIT OF OPERATION must be issued by Alberta Elevating Devices and Amusement Rides Safety Association. This formal temporary permit is intended to allow the association time needed for data entry and scheduling of the ongoing issuance of permits of operation.
- This temporary permit is valid up to the expiry date shown above.
- No fee is required for this certificate however, it is only valid if the initial inspection fee is paid.
- All directives MUST be completed “before operation” as noted on the Safety Codes Officers written initial inspection report.
- The conveyance in this application will be maintained by qualified persons in a safe operating condition in accord with the applicable code.
- An Agent is a person or firm that is authorized by the owner to act on the owner’s behalf.
- Retain a copy of this application as your TEMPORARY PERMIT OF OPERATION.
- This permit applies to the device listed above
