

Scona Road Bridge and 98 Avenue Bridge Rehabilitation

Rehabilitation work on two bridges, Scona Road over Connors Road and 98 Avenue eastbound over Connors Road, is scheduled to begin in mid-April. The bridges will be worked on one after another, beginning with Scona Road Bridge. **Construction is anticipated to be completed by the end of 2024.**

Scope of Work

Scona Road Bridge over Connors Road


- Remove and replace the deteriorated concrete pavement on the bridge deck
- Remove and replace asphalt pavement at each end of the bridge
- Perform additional repairs to extend the operating life of the bridge

98 Avenue Bridge eastbound over Connors Road

- Remove and replace the deteriorated concrete pavement on the bridge deck
- Perform additional repairs to extend the operating life of the bridge

Access

During construction, lane reductions will be in place and access will be maintained. Scona Road Bridge work will require a full road closure during concrete pours. During this time, detours will be marked, with advanced notice provided, and access will be maintained to nearby properties. This work may require a full closure of the roadway beneath it, Connors Road, to ensure safety to motorists. Closures will be scheduled for non-event weekends whenever possible. Nearby bus stops and pedestrian access will not be affected. Access to nearby residential properties will be maintained at all times.
