

Swimming Pool Serviceperson

DEFINITION

This is unskilled manual work in the cleaning and care of swimming pools and premises.

Work of this class involves the performance of a variety of cleaning and minor maintenance tasks following well established routines at an assigned pool facility. Responsibilities include; cleaning of dressing rooms, washrooms, and locker rooms, and minor maintenance of pool systems and other related equipment, and vacuuming swimming pool. Work is inspected upon completion for adherence to instructions, maintenance schedules and work standards.

TYPICAL DUTIES*

Cleans, dusts, polishes, etc., front foyer and gallery area; collects and removes refuse; vacuums and cleans pool; washes walls and windows; dusts, vacuums, cleans, polishes, etc., offices and other work areas.

Sweeps sidewalk and cleans snow.

Cleans restrooms and replenishes supplies; unstops sinks and toilets and reports the need for repairs or supplies.

Inspects buildings and may be required to check operation of facilities.

Maintains pool and facility related systems by making adjustments.

May perform minor maintenance duties on pool facilities. Informs supervisor of any abnormalities.

Tests water conditions and records results as required.

Replaces light bulbs and makes minor repairs to buildings.

Keeps records of work performed and janitorial supplies as required.

Maintains good public relations.

Performs related work as required.

KNOWLEDGE, ABILITIES AND SKILLS

Ability to acquire knowledge of the standard methods, material and equipment employed in the care and maintenance of swimming pools and related facilities.

Ability to understand and execute oral and written instructions. Physical strength and agility sufficient to perform the work of the class.

Completion of the eighth school grade or an equivalent; minimal swimming ability.
