Edmonton Elections

The non-partisan team within the Office of the City Clerk, plans and executes the Edmonton Election on behalf of:

- City of Edmonton,
- Edmonton School Division
- Edmonton Catholic Separate School Division





Notice of Intent vs Nomination

Notice of Intent

- Required step for candidates who wish to collect campaign contributions and incur campaign expenses
- Submit anytime during the **Campaign Period** (Oct. 31, 2024-Dec. 31, 2025)
- No legislated form

Nomination Process

- Required for candidate to appear on ballot
- Submit during the Nomination Period (Jan. 2-Sept. 22, 2025)
- Legislated form must be used





Nomination Process

Nomination Period: January 2-September 22, 2025

Candidates must:

- Confirm they meet eligibility requirements
- Complete the nomination forms
 - Collect signatures from eligible residents
 - *Affirm with Commissioner of Oaths
- Submit the completed form and a deposit to Edmonton Elections, in-person or by mail





Eligibility Requirements

- At least 18 years old on Nomination Day (September 22, 2025)
- A Canadian citizen
- A resident of the City of Edmonton for the 6 consecutive months immediately preceding Nomination Day (September 22, 2025)
- A resident of Edmonton on Election Day (October 20, 2025)
- Not otherwise ineligible or disqualified under the Local Authorities Election Act





Nomination Forms

2 required forms— Form 4 and Form 5—and 1 optional contact information form

Form 4

- Separate form for each office
- Signatures must be inked and collected on the appropriate form
- Signed by Commissioner of Oaths

Form 5

Personal and financial information

Optional form

• Social media, web and campaign contact

Signatures and Deposits

Signature eligibility

- Eligible to vote for the candidate they are signing for on Election Day
 - Canadian Citizen
 - Mayor: Edmonton resident
 - City Councillor and Trustee: ward resident

Deposit

- Paid when submitting nomination papers
 - Cash, debit, credit, certified cheque, money or e-transfer order in person
 - Certified cheque, money order or e-transfer via mail



Submitting Nomination Forms

By appointment

- Book an appointment by:
 - Calling or emailing Edmonton Elections
 - Using the **new online** appointment calendar*
- Appointments take place at Edmonton Elections Office and City Hall (twice a month)

Drop-in

• Drop-in services are available at Edmonton Elections Office, pending staff availability

Nomination papers do not need to be signed by a Commissioner of Oaths before the appointment



Nomination Tips

Collecting signatures:

- Exceed the minimum of signatures required
- Only accept signatures from eligible Edmontonians
- Ensure addresses are complete and legible

Filling out nomination forms:

- Review the supporting materials and double check your forms
- Submit in-person and make an appointment
- Bring all forms and a government issued ID to the appointment
