Construction Bulletin

156 Street to St. Albert Trail

March 20, 2023

Project Overview

Construction of the 156 Street to St. Albert Trail project began in summer 2021. The project includes the removal of the at-grade intersections at 149 Street and 142 Street, construction of one-way service roads parallel to Yellowhead Trail, utility relocations, drainage improvements and replacement of the Dovercourt noise wall.

Progress Update

Upcoming spring construction activities include the **permanent removal of the at-grade signalized intersection at 149 Street**. Left turns from 149 Street to Yellowhead Trail and from Yellowhead Trail to 149 Street will no longer be permitted. Additionally, 149 Street northbound approaching Yellowhead Trail eastbound will be detoured to 142 Street via 124 Avenue.

Schedule

Removal of the existing traffic signals at Yellowhead Trail and 149 Street is scheduled for **Saturday, April 15, 2023**. Please note that construction schedules are weather dependent and subject to change.

Traffic Accommodations (Map attached)

- Permanent removal of left turns to and from Yellowhead Trail at 149 Street.
- Temporary closure of the northbound to eastbound movement at 149 Street.
- Vehicle and pedestrian access across Yellowhead Trail at 149 Street will no longer be permitted.
- Two lanes of traffic will be maintained east and westbound on Yellowhead Trail.
- Travellers may use 124 Avenue, 123 Avenue, and 128 Avenue to the 156 Street Interchange, St Albert Trail Interchange and 142 Street .
- Business access will be maintained at all times.
- Emergency access will be maintained at all times.

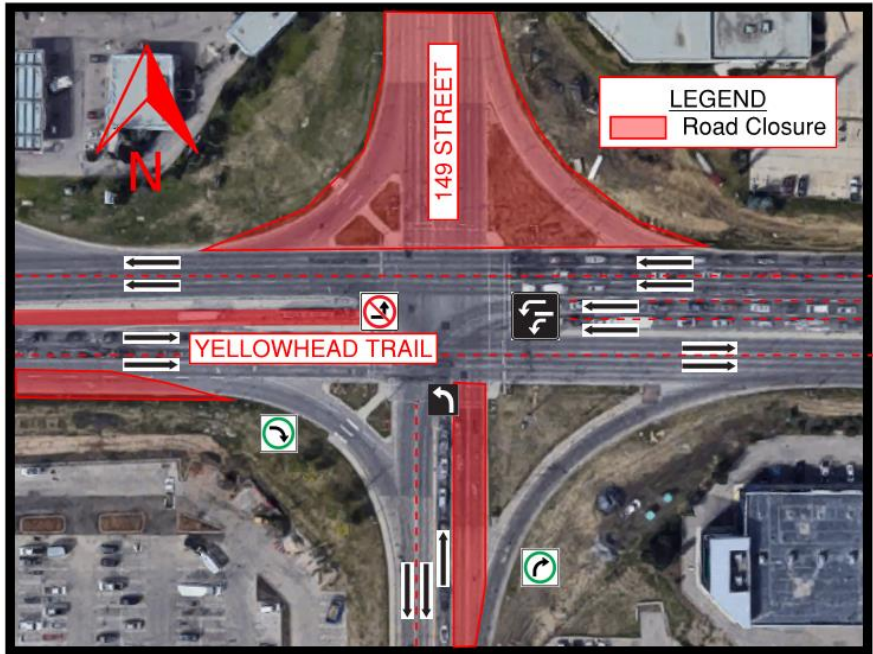

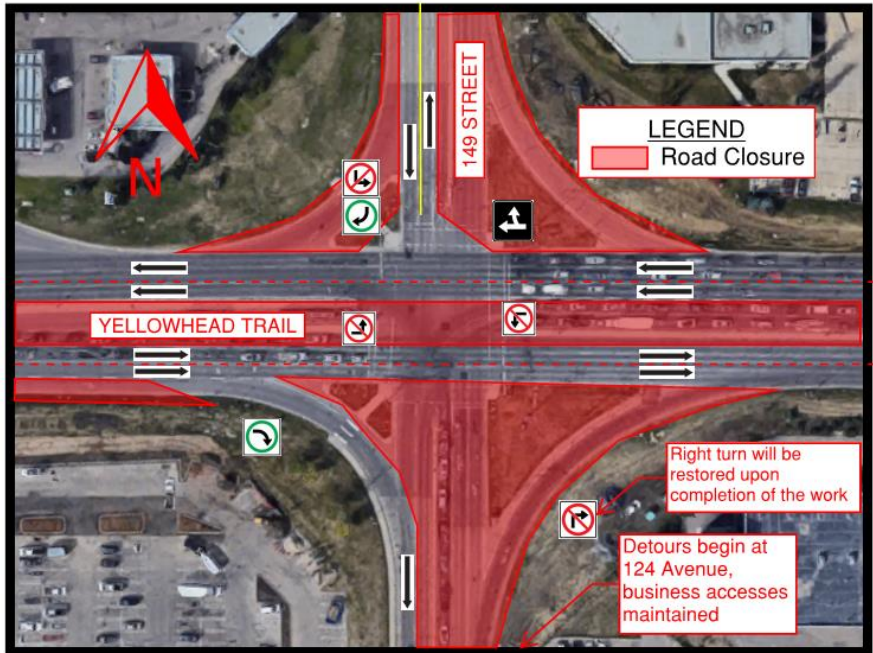
