Fort Road Widening

September 16, 2022

Project Overview

As part of the Yellowhead Trail Freeway Conversion Program, the City of Edmonton is widening Fort Road from four lanes to six lanes, which includes reconstructing the existing CN Rail bridge structure to accommodate the widened roadway. The project also includes the construction of an industrial collector road (125 Avenue) providing improved business access connecting Yellowhead Trail westbound from 61 Street to Fort Road.

Purpose of Bulletin

To provide awareness that Fort Road will reopen to traffic on or around **Sunday, September 18, 2022**.

Current or Upcoming Construction Activities

- Paving and associated road construction will continue into the fall.
- Construction to lengthen the CN Rail Bridge will continue into the winter.

Traffic Accommodation (Map attached)

- Fort Road is being reopened to single lane traffic in both directions under the CN rail bridge, including a pedestrian walkway.
- 66 Street will remain open in both directions from Yellowhead Trail to Fort Road.
- 125 Avenue will be closed between Fort Road and 66 Street to facilitate road work along Fort Road. Local business access will be maintained to the Kathleen Andrews Transit Garage.
- Access for businesses along Fort Road and 66 Street will be maintained at all times.
- Emergency access will be maintained at all times.
- Residents on 126A Avenue will continue to use 127 Avenue for access.
- No parking will be permitted in signed areas during construction.
