Tentative plan of subdivision to create 126 single detached residential lots, 138 semi-detached residential lots and one (1) Public Utility lot, from SW-22-51-24-4, Lot 3, Block X, Plan 1027150, and Lot 1, Plan 7920978, located north of 25 Avenue SW and east of 90 Street SW; SUMMERSIDE

#### I The Subdivision by Plan is APPROVED on August 7, 2014, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. that the owner provide money in place of Municipal Reserve, in the amount of \$2,468,271 representing 3.331 ha pursuant to Section 666 and Section 667 of the Municipal Government Act;
- 2. that the owner enter into a Servicing Agreement with the City of Edmonton pursuant to Section 655 of the Municipal Government Act;
- 3. that the owner prepare the necessary plans and documentation to grant new or carry forward existing easements and restrictive covenants in favour of the City of Edmonton, EPCOR Distribution and Transmission Inc., and EPCOR Water Services Inc., as required by the aforementioned agencies or shown on the engineering drawings that are deemed to be part of the Servicing Agreement;
- 4. that the owner be permitted to register this plan of subdivision in stages, at the discretion of the Chief Subdivision Officer, having regard to the provision of roadways, Municipal Reserve and the logical extension of services, as shown on the "Conditions of Approval" map, Enclosure I; and
- 5. that the owner pay all outstanding property taxes prior to the endorsement of the plan of subdivision.

### II That the Servicing Agreement required in Clause 1(2) contain, among other things, the following:

- 1. that the owner pay all servicing costs, assessments, roadway modification costs (including but not limited to sidewalk, shared use path and/or transit infrastructure), construction costs and inspection costs required by this subdivision;
- 2. that the owner pay all costs specified in the Servicing Agreement prior to endorsement of the plan of survey;

- 3. that the owner pay the Drainage Assessments applicable to this subdivision;
- 4. that the owner pay the Arterial Roadway Assessments applicable to this subdivision;
- 5. that the owner submit an Erosion and Sediment Control (ESC) Plan specific for this development and for implementation during and after construction in accordance with the City of Edmonton ESC Guidelines and Field Manual;
- 6. that the owner submit detailed engineering drawings and technical studies in accordance with the City of Edmonton Design and Construction Standards and to the satisfaction of the City Departments and affected utility agencies;
- 7. that the owner construct a temporary 4 m gravel emergency access with T-Bollards, to the satisfaction of Transportation Services, as shown on the "Conditions of Approval" map, Enclosure I. This roadway will be required prior to CCC for roads (or when required by Transportation Services);
- 8. that the owner construct a 1.5 m concrete sidewalk connection from the sidewalk around the cul-de-sac on 86 Street SW to Savaryn Drive, and a 3 m concrete emergency access, to the satisfaction of Transportation Services, as shown on the "Conditions of Approval" map, Enclosure I. The emergency access will be required prior to CCC for roads (or when required by Transportation Services);
- 9. that the owner construct a 3 m hard surface shared use path with a dividing yellow centerline, "Shared Use" signage, lighting, and bollards to the satisfaction of Transportation Services, as shown on the "Conditions of Approval" map, Enclosure I;
- 10. that the owner construct two 1.5 m concrete sidewalks within the walkways, with lighting and bollards to the satisfaction of Transportation Services, as shown on the "Conditions of Approval" map, Enclosure I;
- 11. that the owner construct a 1.8 m noise attenuation fence contained wholly within private property, as per the City of Edmonton Roadway Design Standards Drawing #5205, for all lots backing onto or flanking 25 Avenue SW, to the satisfaction of Transportation Services, as shown on the "Conditions of Approval" map, Enclosure I;
- 12. that the owner construct all fences wholly on privately-owned lands, to the satisfaction of Transportation Services and Sustainable Development, as shown on the "Conditions of Approval" map, Enclosure I; and
- 13. that the owner is responsible for the landscape design and construction within the Public Utility lot, road islands, boulevards, medians, walkways, and greenways, to the satisfaction of City Departments and affected utility agencies.

Enclosure I is a map of the subdivision identifying major conditions of this approval.

Municipal Reserves for Lot 3, Block X, Plan 10271150 have been addressed through SUB/99-0072. Municipal Reserves for SW-22-51-24-4 and Lot 1, Plan 7920978 are being provided as money in place of land with this subdivision.

Please be advised that an appeal may be lodged in accordance to Section 678 of the Municipal Government Act with the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board, 10019 103 Avenue, Edmonton Alberta, T5J 0G9, within 14 days from the date of the receipt of this decision. The date of receipt of the decision is deemed to be five (5) days from the date the decision is mailed.


