Surveys

- + An online survey was available to the public from November 5–26, 2020, asking residents to help us **CREATE** a Vision and Guiding Principles for Baturyn's Neighbourhood Renewal. We also asked for help identifying opportunities to improve and **REFINE** the area.
- + Paper copies were made available at the Baturyn Community League speak board.

Workshops

- + On November 10, 2020, stakeholders were invited to participate in a conversation to discuss what they like about Baturyn and identify areas for improvement.
- + On December 8, 2020, stakeholders met again to **CREATE** the draft Vision and Guiding Principles.

Online Engagement

- + From November 5–26, 2020, citizens shared their feedback online about Baturyn. Engagement options included a self-guided tour of the neighbourhood, sharing ideas and stories about Baturyn as well as mapping locations that could be **REFINED** and use improvement.
- + Over 50 people signed up for project updates.
- + The self-guided walking tour was also available in a paper copy at the Baturyn Community League speak board and we received 5 guides full of comments from community members.
- + We received 2 stories illustrating people's experiences, 11 visions of a future Baturyn and 121 pins on the map to identify where opportunities and issues exist. Overall, there were 21 engaged, 99 informed and 199 aware participants.
