Workshop

- + A community Vision and Guiding Principles Workshop was held on June 19, 2019 at the Malmo Plains Community League Hall.
- + Participants were introduced to the Neighbourhood Renewal program and asked about four topics: Vision and Guiding Principles, Community Spaces, Getting Around, and Safety.

Walking Tour

- + A community Walking Tour was held on July 9, 2019.
- + Participants guided the project team through the Malmo Plains neighbourhood and pointed out issues and opportunities for improvement around the neighbourhood.

Online Engagement

- + Three online engagement tools were available for the public to provide input: a survey, virtual mapping tool and online question and answer forum.
- + The online survey was available from June 19 to July 3, 2019.
- + The virtual mapping tool was available from July 9 to July 31, 2019.
- + The online survey allowed the public to provide input on issues and opportunities for improvement in the neighbourhood.
- + The virtual mapping tool allowed the public to place pins and provide feedback on a variety of topics.
- + The online question and answer forum allowed the public to pose project related questions for the project team members to answer.

Over 40 Participants & Over 100 Map Pins

Feedback collected from the public engagement activities will be used to create a draft Vision and Guiding Principles and to inform the neighbourhood renewal plans. A report on what we heard will be available online in September 2019 and provided at future public engagement events.
