

NEIGHBOURHOOD DESCRIPTION

Hairsine is a fully developed neighbourhood bounded by 137th Avenue, 144th Avenue, 36th Street and Victoria Trail. The area was annexed by the City of Edmonton in 1961, and the community became part of the Clareview Outline Plan in 1972. Development in Hairsine started in the 1970s and continued into the 1980s.

The majority of the dwelling units in the Hairsine neighbourhood are located in row housing and low rise apartment structures. A shared school and park site is located in the middle of the neighbourhood. Commercial amenities are available along 137th Avenue and along Victoria Trail, and extensive amenities are also available in nearby Clareview Town Centre. An LRT station is also located in the Clareview Town Centre area.

Hairsine was named in honour of Albert Hairsine who was the first mayor of the Town of Beverly. He served as mayor until 1951.
