# Project Background


Alley Renewal involves alley reconstruction and repaving, improvements to surface drainage wherever possible and upgrading existing alley lighting to LED fixtures. It also includes the opportunity for a local improvement to add alley lighting if property owners are interested.

North Glenora has been chosen for Alley Renewal with construction anticipated to begin in spring 2021 and continue into 2022.

# What we did



On Thursday, March 25 from 6:30 to 7:30 p.m., we hosted a virtual information session to inform residents about upcoming construction and also provide them with the opportunity to ask questions. The information session was promoted with road signs, postcards that were dropped off at each residence and in the North Glenora community newsletter.

## What we heard

Below is a summary of questions and concerns residents had during the information session:

- + **Parking:** Residents wanted to know where they would be able to park their vehicles during construction and they were informed to park on the front street or contact the Construction Manager, should they require additional parking considerations.
- + **Construction communications:** It was important to many that construction is properly communicated to all residents, particularly when access will be disrupted.
- + **Drainage issues:** Residents were happy that all drainage issues in the North Glenora alleys would be addressed, where possible.
- + **Waste and recycling collection:** Some asked if waste and recycling collection would still occur, and they were informed that it would be moved to the front street during construction.

# Next Steps

Alley Renewal in North Glenora will start in spring 2021. During construction, alleys will be inaccessible for a minimum of four weeks.

Bulletins will be distributed at the start of construction season to inform residents of the proposed timelines of alley renewal work. A second construction bulletin will be delivered to your property, approximately one week prior to the start of work on your alley. Once the work is complete, City residents will enjoy improved access and use of the alley.
