**PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS**

<b>Public Skate (In blue)</b> <b>Early Skate (In Yellow)</b>	Public skating opportunities for everyone at indoor arenas. <b>Children under the age of 8 must be actively supervised by a responsible person aged 13+</b>
<b>Older Adult</b>	Public skating opportunities for older adults (55+) to skate and socialize
<b>Parents and Tots (P&amp;T)</b>	One half of the rink is available for Parents and Tots skating while the other half is used for Sticks and pucks for Toddlers who want to practice their skills (pick up shinny & Goaltending not permitted) A skate monitor will be available to help facilitate this opportunity ** Children must be of pre-school age 0-6 yrs (*walking) and actively supervised by an adult 13 + *children & adults must be on skates. Caregivers are not allowed to carry child
<b>Downtown Community League Skate</b>	Public skating opportunities for residents of Boyle Street, McCauley, Downtown, Central McDougall, Queen Mary Park and Oliver Community Leagues.
