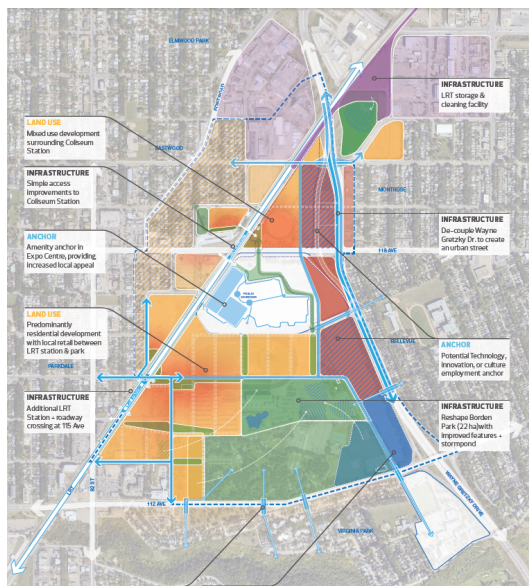


## Update on Engagement Activities and Opportunities

Since this is part of a larger event, the main focus will not be on Exhibition Lands. However, we will have project information to review and staff will be on hand to hear feedback on the concepts.

The event is being hosted as part of the City of Edmonton's Neighbourhood Renewal program for mature neighbourhoods. Planning is underway for the Highlands neighbourhood, which will see the replacement of its aging collector and local roadway surfaces, street lights and sidewalks beginning in 2019 and ending in 2021.
