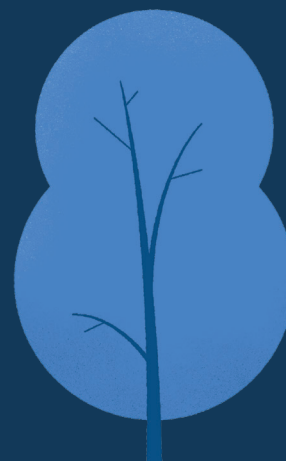




How we *grow* together



The City of Edmonton is proposing the development of a medium-density apartment building at **11039, 11045 and 11049 130 Street.**

We have partnered with Homeward Trust on a proposal for approx. 60 units of supportive housing.

Supportive housing is not a homeless shelter or transitional housing. It is an apartment building for Edmontonians who have experienced homelessness and need support to maintain their housing. Residents receive the 24/7 on-site health, wellness and life skills support they need to succeed.

Next Steps

A proposal to sell the land to Homeward Trust will go to City Council for approval on February 22, 2021. You can watch the meeting and/or request to speak at **edmonton.ca/meetings**

If the land sale is approved, the City and Homeward Trust will hold digital engagement with the community. We look forward to hearing from you and gathering your input on a Good Neighbour Plan.
