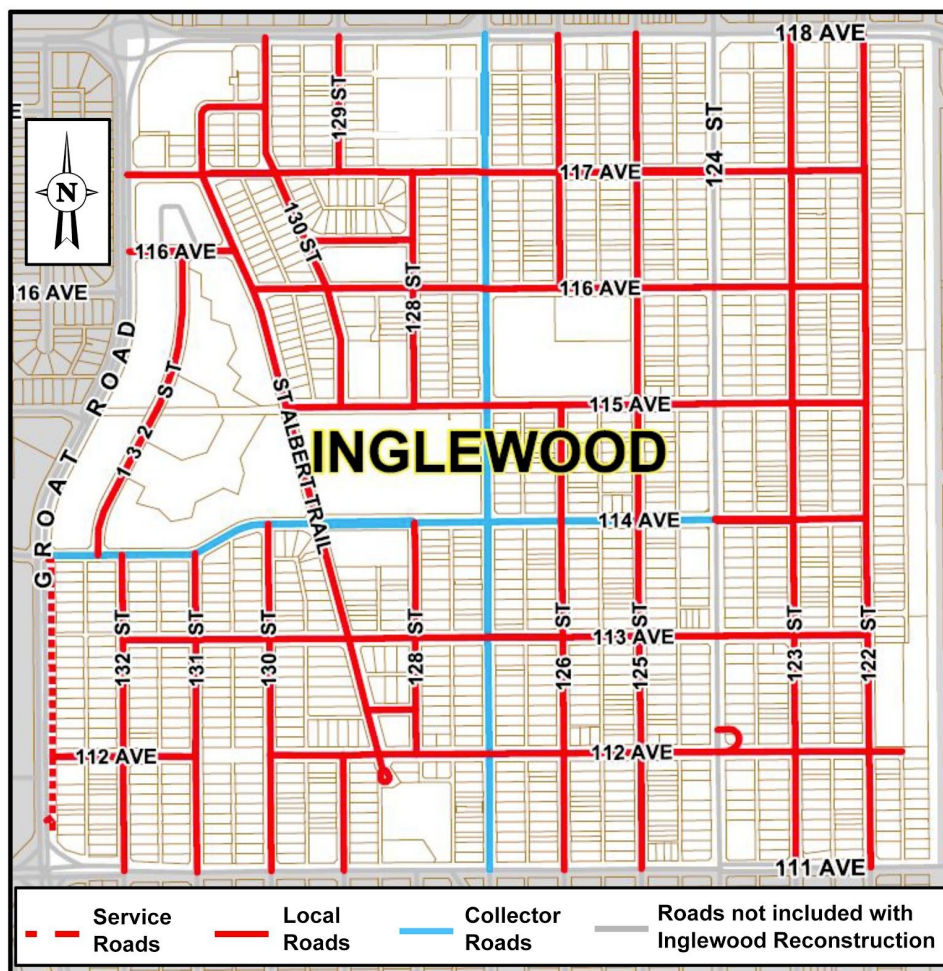

In 2019 - 2021, Inglewood will see the replacement of its aging collector and local roadway surfaces, streetlights, and sidewalks as part of the City of Edmonton's Neighbourhood Renewal program for mature neighbourhoods. Planning for this renewal has recently begun. A new dedicated City branch, Building Great Neighbourhoods, will also explore the redevelopment of other City-owned areas within the community, including green spaces and parks, and look for opportunities and funding to make desired upgrades and enhancements in coordination with the Neighbourhood Renewal program.
