

# Safe Speeds Toolkit: Community Signs on Public Road Space

*Please find below some helpful Do's & Don'ts for sign placement to make this program a success!*

## Do

- ✓ Use the metal frame provided to stake your signs firmly and securely in a grassy boulevard area.
- ✓ Place signs at least 0.5 metres from road curbs, sidewalk edges and shared pathways.
- ✓ Space your signs out for maximum impact. Avoid locations that already have a lot of signs, as too many signs can be confusing!
- ✓ Tell a story about safe speeds in your community by using the different signs and colors to draw attention to your message.
- ✓ Keep your signs in the public space for 14 days, then move them to new locations to spark new attention!
- ✓ Check on your signs regularly to ensure they are in their intended location.
- ✓ Follow all [sign placement guidelines](#).

## Don't

- X Create tripping or sightline hazards with your signs.
- X Place signs on roadways, centre medians, traffic islands, or traffic circles.
- X Place signs on any structures, such as bridges and guardrails, traffic control devices (ie: stop lights and stop signs) or on plants or shrubs.
