

## Project Overview



Confederation District Park (11204 43 Ave NW), located in the mature neighbourhood of Royal Gardens, is identified as a priority for renewal to update park infrastructure and amenities.

Confederation District Park has a catchment area of approximately 2.5km and is home to two high schools, sports fields, a running track, basketball and tennis courts and a community Leisure Centre and Arena. The park is also connected to communities north of Whitemud Drive by a bridge which links to bike routes, the River Valley and the Edmonton Transit System.

To develop a long-term vision for the site we are creating a master plan that considers input from the public and stakeholders. We want to know what you love about this park, how you use the park and what could be improved to better suit your needs.

## Project Phases




**Fall 2016- Fall 2017**


