Safe Speeds Toolkit - Messaging for Changeable Message Boards

Use a Safe Speeds Toolkit to support the implementation of the 40 km/h speed limit and address ongoing concerns about speeding in your neighbourhood. One tool in the toolkit is community signage - signage can be a helpful tool for raising awareness and reminding people to drive safely.

Changeable Message Boards

Look around your community. Does your local school, grocery store, or community league have a customizable message board? If so, they may be willing to place a message on their sign temporarily to support safe and livable streets in the community.

Sample Messaging

Here are some sample messages you can use!

Messaging to address ongoing concerns about speeding in your neighbourhood:
