




BLOCK PLAN • Jasper Avenue - 110 Street to 109 Street








BLOCK PLAN • Jasper Avenue - 124 Street to 123 Street











DRAFT KEY PLAN • Jasper Avenue - 124 Street to 109 Street





Flex Space

Varies between blocks and along individual blocks. Uses can include boardwalks, patios, motor vehicle or bike parking, loading zones, accessible parking, and taxi stands



Pedestrian Through Zone

An unobstructed space for pedestrian mobility for people of all ages and abilities



Furnishing Zone

An area for signs, light and signal poles, trees, and benches



Amenity Zone

A flexible space within the sidewalk area that can be used for additional landscaping, seating, patios, furnishing, or additional pedestrian and gathering space
