The purpose of this study is to develop a streetscape concept plan for Jasper Avenue between 109 Street and 124 Street.


Project Goal: To envision an innovative, vibrant and relevant streetscape that will strive to balance the needs of the community, commuters, businesses and visitors.

Project Area Map








What is a Streetscape?

- Refers to how a street looks, feels and functions
- Considers how the street impacts all users (pedestrians, cyclists, transit riders and drivers)
- Addresses sidewalks, landscaping, lighting, street furniture, signage, connectivity, crosswalks, universal design, traffic management, parking, safety, maintenance and more



Main Street Jasper Avenue

- Jasper Avenue was designated as a 'Main Street' in 2015 following an amendment to the Complete Streets Policy.
- The City's Main Street Guidelines along with public engagement and technical studies will guide the development of the Streetscape Concept Plan
- The Streetscape Concept Plan will establish road and sidewalk widths, as well as other streetscape elements
- The Main Street will evolve over many years





Main Streets Guidelines

Edmonton's Complete Streets Policy now includes a definition of Main Streets and a provision that they are to be designed and maintained to an enhanced standard.

Main Streets are both a Link and a Place

- Support a Network of Streets

What We Heard

What People Like about Jasper Avenue

- Pride in and connection with the community
- History and character of area
- Proximity to River Valley
- Great destinations, services and shops
- Strong and diverse community
- New pedestrian crossing lights

What People Dislike about Jasper Avenue

- Visually unappealing, lacks trees and greenery
- Noisy and vehicle-focused
- Narrow sidewalks and in poor condition
- Poor connections to adjacent amenities

Ideas for Future Improvement

- Improve connectivity between key destinations
- Create an inviting and pedestrian-friendly space
- Increase landscaping and greenery
- Align future development with Vision
- Improve accessibility and safety for families, seniors and persons with disabilities
- Create resting and gathering spaces
- Include the needs of all travelers, including residents and commuters
- Integrate place-making features, public art and artistic streetscape elements
- Enhance transit service and LRT connections



Vision and Principles

Jasper Avenue is Edmonton's premier Main Street - a people place.


- Create a vibrant, all seasons destination a safe place of social gathering for all ages and abilities
- Shape a community street celebrate the history and diversity of Jasper Avenue's people
- Put pedestrians first, ensuring travel options for all users increase the priority on pedestrians, while recognizing the needs of all methods of transportation
- Increase the green enhance and beautify Jasper Avenue with tree planting and landscaping
- Consider the big picture reinforce connections to local destinations and promote high quality development





Understanding Design Elements & Tradeoffs

- To achieve the Imagine Jasper Avenue Vision and design a Main Street streetscape, the roadway and public realm space will need to be allocated differently.
- Increasing sidewalk width and planting trees will impact the current roadway function. It is important to determine value priorities for the avenue to help decide what's most important and the necessary trade-offs.



Examples

- Trees vs. on-street parking
- Wider sidewalks vs. bus-only lane
- Turning lanes vs. patio space
